Class 1 have had a busy week this week. In Maths we have started our next unit on addition and subtraction and in English we've been exploring our new book, Tadpole's promise.


We have also had great fun with Miss Squire learning about travelling and jumping in Dance and explored how colour was created and made in Prehistoric Britain in our Art lesson.
