FOBS News

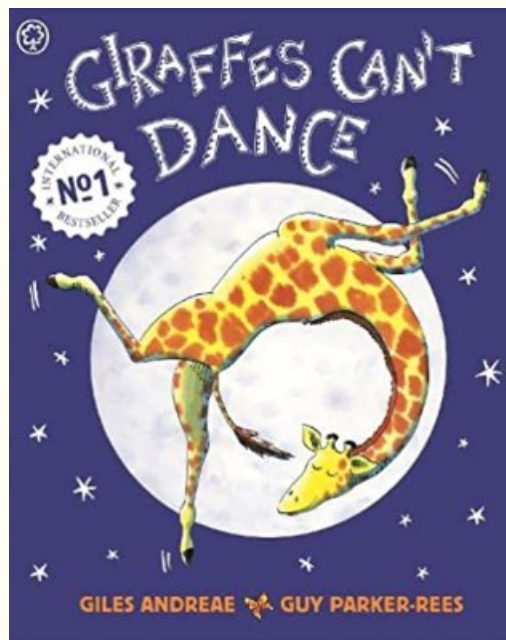
Over the next couple of weeks FOBs are running some great events that they would love to invite you to.

FSUNews

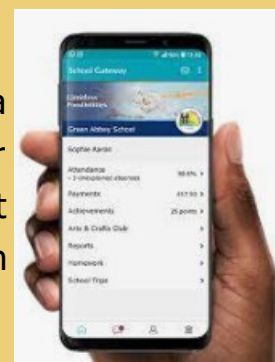
